

HIGHLANDS TOP AT 1,500gns

The Highland Cattle Society's Southern Show and Sale at Worcester enjoyed tremendous support from a capacity crowd and strong, if somewhat selective, buying power.

Top price of the day was 1,500gns in the bull section for "Ulysses of Hellifield" from Robert Philips Fold based in Skipton, Yorkshire. The bull took second prize in the show and was finally secured by J & F Farms, Melbourne, Derby. Michael Poland consigned an excellent string from his Mottistone Fold and was duly rewarded with a top of 1,150gns for his bull "Eoin Mhor 2nd of Mottistone to A Harrison, East Grinstead, Sussex.

Top in the female section was shared with two animals levelling at 1,000gns. an in calf heifer, again from Michael Poland was secured by R Travers, Dunsfold Surrey having taken First prize in the preceding show. The other 1,000gns shout was from the First and Reserve Female Champion "Fleur of Eckington" a maiden heifer from Mrs Judy Gardner's local fold near Pershore, Worcestershire.
