All Bulls put forward at the Sale must have a nose ring in place. This is in keeping with the guidelines of government legislation and health and safety requirements.

Bull Calves will be exempt and will only require a snitch in order to maintain control.

A Bull Calf will be classified as such until twelve (12) months old, thereafter a nose ring will be required.

(All females born on before 31 December 2017 must be scanned, Pd'd or stated on the entry form as 'in calf' or with calf at foot. Written confirmation must be received by 31 January)

1/1/2018 – 31/12/2018

**SECTION 7****Two Year Old Heifers**

1/1/2019 – 31/12/2019

**SECTION 8****Yearling Heifers**

1/01/2020 – 10/8/2020

**SECTION 9****Cows**

(All females born on before 31 December 2017 must be scanned, Pd'd or stated on the entry as 'in calf' or with calf at foot. Written confirmation must be received by 31 January)

Un-Haltered; Registered Heifers or Cows under seven years must be guaranteed in calf.

**Online Entry System**

After entering the sales entry system, you will be asked to validate or change the health declaration details. The sales system then allows you to select an animal for entry to the sale. The system will return the data on that animal from the herd book. Please check that the data is correct.

Additional data can be added in the screen or later in the free format screen which allows you to enter as much detail as you like.

You can delete the entry at any time up to the closing date of midnight January 15, 2021, after which the entry will be in the sales catalogue.

We will remind you of the closing date later in the year, along with any changes to the way sales are being held in the auction marts.
